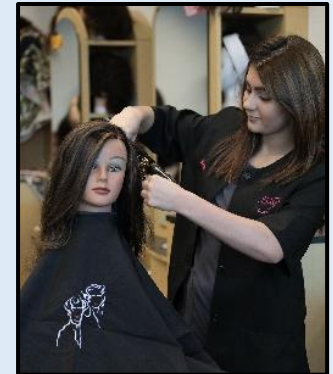


COSMETOLOGY

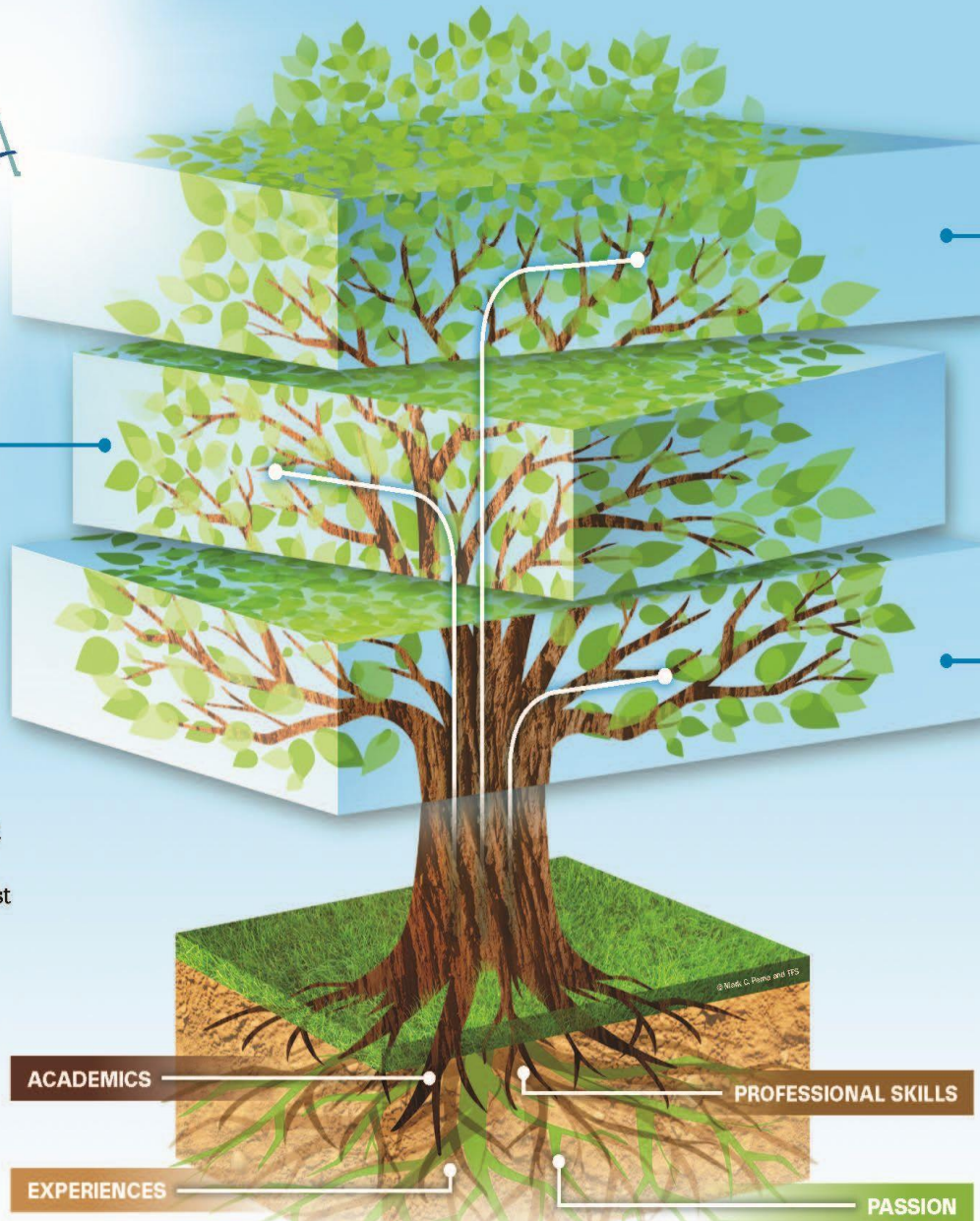
