

## **Harassment Reports Filed 2017-2018 School Year**

**The Penta Career Center Board of Education encourages the promotion of positive interpersonal relationships between members of the school community. Harassment/bullying is defined as any intentional written, verbal, or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior causes both:**

- mental or physical harm to the student;**
- severe, persistent, or pervasive that creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student.**

**Ohio Revised Code (3319.321) requires that the Penta Career Center administration semiannually provide the president of the district board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on its web site, if the district has a web site.**

**During the first semester of the 2017-2018 school year, Penta Career Center had seven (7) incidences of harassment that would meet the definition by law.**
