This two-week course will teach students the simple but important knowledge to maintain their own vehicle. Intended as a personal-interest course, students will learn the importance of scheduled maintenance, perform a pre-trip safety inspection, change a tire, and perform simple repairs on a do-it-yourself level. Additional instructions will include choosing a repair shop and finding emergency service when out of town.

CONTENT: Shop safety. Reading and understanding the owner's manual. Changing engine oil and coolant. Inspecting tires, vehicle lighting and safety features. Performing minor repairs.
