"The education and skills from Penta prepared me for my entire career," said Austin. "Chef Rhegness took me under his wings and has been a tremendous mentor ever since."

In 2011, after completing the Culinary Arts program at Penta and graduating from Northwood High School, Austin attended The Culinary Institute of America (CIA) in Hyde Park, New York. He not only earned a hospitality management degree from the CIA, but he also received a joint degree from Cornell University.

Austin's professional career is impressive. He has managed and led several kitchens and restaurants for Marriott and Ritz-Carlton hotels.
