Congratulations to our 2024 Penta Outstanding Alumni!



When Alyssa Johnson was young, she enjoyed helping her mother with cooking and baking. This interest continued in high school and when she heard about Penta's Culinary Arts program, she jumped at the chance to experience this exciting career path.

Alyssa graduated from Perrysburg High School and completed the Culinary Arts program at Penta in 2013. While at Penta, she participated in many activities that helped her prepare for college and her career. Alyssa earned the ProStart certification and the ProStart Top Culinarian Award during her senior year. She also was active in career-technical student organizations like FCCLA and SkillsUSA where she earned top awards at regional and state competitions.

"Penta helped shape my career," says Alyssa. "My Penta education gave me a broad overview of the many opportunities that are available in my chosen field and it helped me become successful."

Alyssa attended The Culinary Institute of America (CIA) in Hyde Park, New York where she gained extensive knowledge and experience in baking and pastry. In 2014, she had an exciting opportunity to hone her skills when she participated in a five-month externship at the Grand Hotel Resort and Spa in Point Clear, Alabama. Alyssa earned an associate's degree in baking and pastry from the CIA in 2015.

After graduating from the CIA, Alyssa returned to Perrysburg and worked for Walt Churchill's Market and Element 112. In 2016, she worked as the assistant bakery manager for The Toledo Zoo & Aquarium where she gained more experience supervising hourly employees and managing the day-to-day production.
